The Coors Visitor Centre is only a five minute walk from the hotel, where you can see the history of brewing.



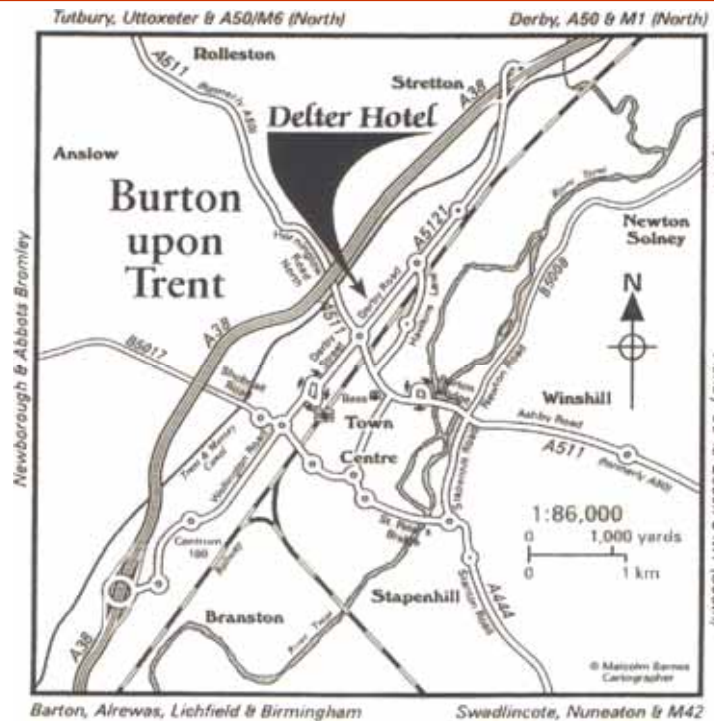
Excitement is never far from the Delter Hotel, with Alton Towers, American Adventure and Drayton Manor Park being only half an hour by car.

Directions

Take junction 24 off the M1, follow the signs A50 for Stoke on Trent, and the signs for Burton-on-Trent. From the A50 follow the A38 to Burton-on-Trent. From A38 follow the signs for the A5121. Go straight over 2 roundabouts and the Delter Hotel is on the right hand side of road, just before the next roundabout.

If you are coming from Birmingham or Litchfield, head for the A38. Leave Burton at the 2nd exit sign posted A5121. Go straight over 2 roundabouts and the Delter Hotel is on the right hand side of road, just before the next roundabout.

Breakfast is served in the dining room on the ground floor which retains many of the Victorian features.



Ample car parking is provided at the front and rear of the hotel.

Most debit and credit cards are accepted including Visa, MasterCard and Maestro.

Burton-on-Trent town centre is half a mile from the Delter Hotel. Here you will find many of the well known retail chains and many other shops in shopping malls and precincts. There is the old established market which has both covered and open areas.



Shopping is in abundance in Birmingham and Nottingham, The Meadowfield Centre in Sheffield is only an hour away. The Shires and Fosse Park are also a short drive away. The pottery shops in Stoke-on-Trent can be reached within half an hour.



The Market towns of Ashby de la Zouch and Uttoxeter are nearby, as is the town of Tutbury which is famous for its castle and crystal glass.



Most Midland Cities are within an hours drive of the Delter Hotel, such as Birmingham, Nottingham, Derby and Leicester.



Many elegant stately homes are only a short drive away. Calke Abbey is only twenty miles away, also Chatsworth, Shrugborough, Haddon Hall and many others are less than an hour from the hotel.



Visit the historic centres of Warwick and Stratford on Avon, all within easy reach of the Delter Hotel in and Burton-on-Trent
